

Launch of the first International Master in Phytotherapy in Cagliari. Graduates receive a dual qualification.

Pre-enrolments for 2009-2010 are open on the site of the Master's course. In December the university announcement will be published, after which there will only be 60 days to complete the enrolment procedure.

The Master in Phytotherapy, the only one of its kind in Italy, now in its second edition becomes **the first Internationalised Master**, which therefore issues a post-graduate specialisation in Phytotherapy in conjunction with a foreign partner. The mixed course will be conducted by the University of Cagliari and by the Universidad Complutense de Madrid, so graduates will obtain a **dual qualification: Master 2nd level in Phytotherapy**, issued by the Italian university, and **Titulo de Especialista in Fitoterapia de la UCM**, issued by the Spanish university. Both are recognised in all the EU countries.

Given the major success of the 2008-2009 edition, the number of places has been increased to 40 and up to five grants are available. The Master's course, reserved to doctors and chemists, involves three intensive one-week sessions and provides 60 CFUs (university credits). Participants will be exempt from ECM credits for the entire duration of the course.
